Where is ESB delivering a new battery energy storage system?

This latest battery energy storage system (BESS), currently the largest site of its kind in commercial operation in Ireland, is part of ESB's pipeline of projects which are being delivered at sites in Dublin and Cork - representing an investment of up to EUR300m.

What is the Dublin Energy Hub?

The Dublin Energy Hub, housing the largest battery, serves as a testbed for the future of clean energy in Ireland. It is envisioned as a hub for integrating various green technologies, including offshore wind, hydrogen, and carbon capture and storage, all working together to power a sustainable future for the Emerald Isle.

What is ESB's new lithium-ion asset?

The fast-responding asset will store energy generated by renewable energy and output it to help balance the grid when required. The new 2-hour duration lithium-ion (Li-ion) asset is part of a BESS portfolio into which ESB is investing around EUR300 million (US\$323.5 million).
