Which country has the largest data center capacity in Latin America?

Existing data center capacity in Latin America has grown to over 1.30 GW, with more than 8 million sq. ft. of built space and over 200,000 racks and cabinets. Brazil leads the data center market in Latin America, with the highest share of both existing and upcoming capacity.

How big is the data center market in Latin America?

The data center market in Latin America is expected to double over the next five or so years, from roughly US\$5 to US\$6 billion in 2023 to anywhere from US\$8 to US\$10 billion by 2029. The market is dominated by the usual countries--Brazil, Mexico and Chile--with Colombia, Peru, Costa Rica and Panama as emerging centers for investment.

Will data centers become more remote in Latin America?

As land becomes more expensive and local entities step up to fill the increasing demand, we expect to see more remote data centers "emerging across Latin America outside of the common urban agglomerations, which will mean greater demand for greenfield water and power infrastructure requiring investment and financing.
