When was Tripoli launched?

Tripoli was launched on 1 May and later christened on 16 September 2017, with Lynne Mabus (wife of former Navy Secretary Ray Mabus) as her sponsor. By 2019, Tripoli was about a year behind production schedules. The ship was delivered to the Navy on 28 February 2020 in preparation for commissioning.
